ORDINANCE NO. 283

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ELY, IOWA, BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO PARKING ALLOWED ON ONLY ONE SIDE OF STREET

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Ely, Iowa:

SECTION 1. SECTION MODIFIED. Section 69.11 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Ely, Iowa, is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

69.11 PARKING ALLOWED ON ONLY ONE SIDE OF STREET. No person shall park a vehicle on the side of the street shown below, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a police officer or sheriff's deputy in any of the following locations.

Street Name or Segment of Street	Parking Prohibited
Northgate	north side of street
Wrigley	east side of street
Cominsky	east side of street
Glendale from Banner Valley to Southbrook Drive	east side of street
Traer Street	north side of street
Jappa Road from Dows Street North	east side of road

SECTION 2. REPEALER CLAUSE. Any ordinance, provision or part thereof, which differs or is inconsistent with this ordinance is hereby repealed, to the extent of said difference or inconsistency.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.

94.06 ABANDONMENT PROCEDURES.

- 1. All wells abandoned under the jurisdiction of this chapter or rule shall be abandoned according to the procedures and methods of the Iowa Code. All debris, pump, piping, unsealed liners and any other obstructions, which may interfere with sealing operations, shall be removed prior to abandonment.
- 2. The owner of the well, or the owner's agent, shall notify the city at least forty-eight (48) hours prior to commencement of any well abandonment activities. The Superintendent of the community water system shall observe the abandonment of the well.

SECTION 2. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
