

Pack a cooler, grab your shades and join your friends and neighbors for an adult only (21+) charter bus road trip to Monticello for an epic float party on July 16 down the Maquoketa River! Leave your worries of carpooling or a designated driver behind, we'll handle the transportation. A 56-person charter bus will pick attendees up at City Hall at 8:00am and shuttle everyone to Monticello River Rentals. The rental company will provide tubes and will shuttle everyone to the drop off point AND pick the group up at the end of the float. The charter bus will pick everyone up once they are off the water and head back to Ely. Those attending will need to bring their own coolers, beverages and food. Staff will have an extra cooler of sandwiches and chips for anyone needing something to eat at the end of the float.
