Resident Reminders

1 Developed residential property within the Lity, whether vacant or occupied, is required to be mowed any time the vegetation reaches a height of more than six inches during the months of April, May, June, July, August, September, and October.

1 When mowing your lawns, it is your responsibility to remove the clippings and leaves from the street. Removing the leaves and clippings will prevent the clogging of the storm sewers and have significant benefits for the local lakes and streams as well as aid in drainage during flash flooding events. Thank you!

The City of Ely requires homeowners to trim their trees 10 ft. above sidewalks and 15 ft. above streets.

Effective 2017, utility bills see an increase in 4 water and sewer charges by 2% in the month of July. This is an annual adjustment to offset the increasing costs of utility management.
