Trunk Sewer Project > This project is the upsizing and construction of a large sewer main from the Wastewater treatment plant along Hoosier Creek to Mabie Rd. Bids will be opened the beginning of October and a contract approved by council at the first council meeting in October. It is expected that the contractor will begin the November 1 and will be finished by the end April 2022.

State Street Shoulder Project > This project is the paving of an asphalt shoulder along state street from Merryhill Lane, north to the concrete. This is intended to help stop the loss of pavement along the shoulder. A contract was approved and awarded to L.L. Pelling and the project will be completed by November 5. While work is ongoing, State Street will be limited to one lane. The contractor will have flaggers on site to direct traffic.

City Hall Parking Lot Project > This project is the construction of a 50 spot parking lot next to City Hall. A contract was approved and awarded to Midwest Concrete Inc. Completion date is November 19.

Schulte Park Parking Lot Project > This project is the construction of a parking lot to replace the gravel parking lot at Schulte Park. The City Engineering Staff is working on the plans. The project will be completed by the end of June 2022.

Downtown/Old Town District Masterplan and Infrastructure

Project) A public workshop was held on August 10x. The design team and steering committee is currently producing its final concept and plan for the Old Town District. Once the final recommendations are ready, they will be presented to City Council.

City Hall/Municipal Campus Master Planning > MSA and FEH has been hired to complete a master planning vision for a municipal campus located at the current City Hall site. The goal is to plan and vision for the future use of the area with the construction of a new library, recreation center, city hall, amphitheater, outdoor education, outdoor recreation, and other future community uses.

FEMA Derecho Response > Staff continues to work with FEMA to obtain funding for the reconstruction of roadways used to haul heavy storm debris, clear debris from the Hoosier creek waterway, and improvements to critical infrastructure.


