The Great Pumpkin Float

2nd Annual Pumpkin Float is back in 2022! For this one special night, the City Park pond will come aglow with floating pumpkins. The smell of fire pits and roasting marshmallows will fill the air while your favorite Halloween tunes help to bring the spooky vibe. Ely Parks & Recreation will be selling \$1 s'more kits, hot chocolate, delicious hot dogs and other beverages at the concession stand during the event. Families are welcome to bring snacks and blankets or chairs to sit on.

Want to watch your own pumpkin float on the water? You can! Ely Parks & Rec Staff will provide the rafts (12in. X 12in. foam for your pumpkin) as well as the light - all you need to provide is the carved pumpkin. Your pumpkin MUST weigh 5lbs or less to float. You may carve your pumpkin with a face, polka dots, your initials, or any other design - just make sure it's family friendly. To reserve a raft, you must sign up via CivicRec.

There are a limited number of rafts to reserve in advance - 60 total. The fee is \$2 per raft, families can reserve as many as they would like. One pumpkin per raft, please.

Drinking Water Treatment Facility Project

Per Mayor Miller's monthly newsletter, in August Council approved an RFQ for preliminary engineering services related to a Drinking Water Treatment Facility Project. The goal of this first phase is to get bids on the engineering, award the contract and then put together a design and preliminary cost estimates to present to council and the public. An open house will then be set up for residents to view the plans and understand the benefits and costs associated with the project. This project will only move forward if it is supported by the public. The goal of this project is to reduce the iron in the water and thus the yellowing issue we have.

Ely's Sesquicentennial celebration on August 12 & 13 was one for the record books! Thank you to ALL who came out to help our community celebrate 150 years! To the Planning Committee, History Society, area businesses and organizations that hosted events, our main tent sponsor T&K Roofing, the volunteers, vendors, elected officials, staff and attendees - you all made this such an incredibly special weekend and we cannot thank you enough.

Veterans Memorial

On Monday, August 8, 2022, Aureon and South Slope Cooperative Communications provided a total of \$10,000 to the American Legion St. Quentin Post 555. The American Legion plans to build an All-Veterans Memorial in downtown Ely for the city's revitalization project. Eldy Miller, the mayor of Ely says, "Ely is one of the few small towns doubling its size." The Memorial will be another attraction to bring people into the town.

Using Aureon's and The Iowa Area Development Group's Ripple Effect program to help provide economic development programs to rural lowans, the Ely American Legion was awarded \$5,000 from South Slope Cooperative Communications and \$5,000 from Aureon to assist in engineering and building the Veterans Memorial Monument. Rob Smith, a member of the St. Quentin Post 555 American Legion says, "We want to

support all communities that we serve. This project is a way we can honor all the Veterans in Ely.

An additional \$5,000 is being contributed from Ely's Sesquicentennial proceeds from the beer sales and t-shirt fundraiser, as well as over \$6,000 raised from the Legion's Golf Cart Raffle. This brings the current total to over \$20,000. There will be additional fundraising opportunities over the next year - keep an eye out on the City's Facebook page for more information.
