Water Meters - Radio Reads

With the warmer weather and yards being cleared from melting snow, Public Works will be pushing to get the new radio reads mounted on the outside of homes throughout Ely. These boxes will replace the black rubber rectangles that were previously used to manually read

each homes water meter. With this new system, staff will be able to gather meter reads for large sections of town wirelessly, all at once. The goal is for all homes in Ely to have radio reads mounted within three years.

Register or Renew Your Ely Golf Cart & ATV Permit

It is time to renew your Ely Golf Cart/ATV permit; if you haven't already. Your golf cart/ATV permit is an annual permit that must be renewed by April 1. The registration fee is \$25 per year. The City Clerk or Deputy Clerk must inspect the vehicle before issuing a new registration. The permit and more information can be found online or in person at City Hall.

Flush Water System

Public Works Will Flush Water System in April through June. This is routine maintenance that is performed to maintain good water quality in the system. Throughout this time period you may occasionally notice minor discoloration to the water while the flushing is taking place; the water poses no health risk and is safe to drink. Public Works has a goal of flushing every Ely hydrant in 2021.

Pool Fills / Outside Water Use

In 2017, the City Council passed an ordinance allowing residents to purchase a second meter to track water that is used outside for watering, pool fills, washing cars, etc. Due to this water not going into the sewer, the City gives an allowance for the sewer portion. There are two options available to residents. Option 1: purchase a large water meter and hard plumb it into your home as well as an additional radio read at a cost of \$500. Both meters will be read monthly; sewer will not be charged on the second meter. Option 2: purchase a portable outdoor meter from City Hall for \$75 that can attach directly to your garden hose. At the end of the season, residents must contact City Hall to report their gallons used for the outside meter to be reimbursed for the sewer portion.

Curbside Limb Pickup Policy April - October

- 1. Brush and limbs will be picked up at your curb by the City of Ely Public Works Department every Tuesday starting at 8am during the months of April October at no charge.
- 2. All limbs must be cut to a length not to exceed 8' and must be less than 6" in diameter.
- 3. All limbs must be trimmed of their smaller branches.
- . All limbs and brush shall be placed by the curb in a neat pile.

 Please avoid one large pile but rather put in smaller piles for easy hand pickup.
- 5. **DO NOT** tie or bundle brush together. Simply place them in a pile at curbside.
- 6. All brush and limbs will be chipped on site and may leave a small amount of debris. The homeowner will be responsible to "sweep" this up occasionally.
- 7. This service is not intended for the removal of an entire tree but for trimmings only. If you are removing an entire tree, you should arrange to have it removed and hauled away. In the case of a windstorm or an emergency event, this policy may be changed to accommodate the extra material.
- 8. **DO NOT** place leaves, garden waste or grass clippings at your curbside, they will **NOT** be picked up. These items can be taken to the compost bunker near the water tower at 370 Jappa Road.
- 9. If your brush pile does not follow the guidelines listed above, it will not be picked up by the City.
