St. John's Lutheran Church Receives AED Grant

St. John's Lutheran Church here in Ely had an extra special day in December. Thanks to Kent Noska, a resident in town and congregation member of the church, who successfully applied for assistance in receiving an AED via a grant through Think Safe. AED stands for Automated External Defibrillator is used to help those experiencing sudden cardiac arrest. It's a sophisticated, yet easy-to-use, medical device that can analyze the heart's rhythm and, if necessary, deliver an electrical shock, or defibrillation, to help the heart re-establish an effective rhythm.

In Ely, we are fortunate that our Volunteer Fire Department is located right here in town – meaning that precious minutes can be saved when responding to an emergency. However, an AED may be necessary to use in a moment's notice. In the event to of a medical emergency, always make sure that someone is directed to contact 911 immediately. Pastor Brian wants to stress the importance that in the event of a medical emergency, if you are in or near the Church, this life-saving resource is available to the entire community, all residents and/or visitors. The location of the AED is mounted on the wall just inside their front doors off of Walker Street.

Present to receive the donated AED and the first three trained on how to use it were Pastor Brian Middleswarth, Guy Schultz and Ed Mertens. Thank you to Think Safe and St. John's Lutheran Church for helping to keep our Community safe and prepared!

When It Snows & Snow Emergencies in Ely

Snow removal can be very challenging. Our goal is to remove snow and ice from the streets safely and quickly. Please help by:

- 1) Keeping vehicles off the streets during snow removal whenever possible. The Mayor may declare a Snow Emergency during or immediately after a very heavy snow to further assist the snow removal crews. Parking is prohibited on city streets during a snow. Parking will be allowed within a 48-hour period only after both sides of the street have been fully cleared. Snow Emergency notices will be announced on local TV news channels in the same manner school and other closings are announced, via text through Nixle notifications, on the City's website and on the City's Facebook page.
- 2) Stay at least 50 feet behind snowplow trucks during snow and ice removal.
- 3) The city recommends purchasing 4' orange snow stakes (available at home improvement stores, or similar) and mark the edge of your curb along the street. This helps the plows push snow as far to the edge as possible without getting into your lawn and causing damage. With a blanket of white snow it is very difficult sometimes to know where the road stops and where the lawn starts!

A Courtesy Reminder about Removing Snow and Ice from Sidewalks

It is the duty of property and homeowners to keep sidewalks abutting your property clear of natural accumulations of snow and ice. Sidewalks need to be free of snow and ice within 24 hours of the precipitation. With everyone's cooperation, our sidewalks will be safe for all residents and visitors.

Community Ice Skating Rink

For the duration of winter, the ice rink will be open from 8am – 10pm. Make sure to bring your own skates as they will not be provided by the City. Hockey is permitted ONLY if there are not others looking to ice skate, please be respectful.
