Summer months bring an increased number of golf carts and side-by-sides to city streets in Elv. Driving golf carts and side-by-sides may be a convenient means of transportation around town or may seem like a fun activity for children to do in the summer; however, they are still vehicles that can cause serious harm and even death if not used properly. Our highest priority is to keep everyone safe, which is why the City would like to remind residents and visitors of safety tips and specific City ordinances regarding golf carts: Registered golf carts shall be operated by persons at least 18 years of age possessing a valid lowa operator's license, the number of occupants shall not exceed the number of seats installed by the manufacturer in said vehicle, golf carts may be operated on City streets only between sunrise and sunset. Please remember to: keep feet, legs, arms (entire body) inside the golf cart at all times. All occupants should remain seated when in motion, slow down for turns and obey all traffic laws and DO NOT drive while intoxicated.


