Tree Trimming – The City of Ely requires homeowners to trim their trees 10 ft. above sidewalks and 15 ft. above streets.

Mowing & Grass Clippings -

When mowing your lawns, it is your responsibility to remove the clippings and leaves from the street. Removing the leaves and clippings will prevent the clogging of the storm sewers and have significant benefits for the local lakes and streams as well as aid in drainage during flash flooding events. Thank you!



Ordinance No. 255 Regulating the Mowing of Properties

- 1. Developed residential property within the City, whether vacant or occupied, is required to be mowed any time the vegetation reaches a height of more than six inches during the months of April, May, June, July, August, September, and October.
- 2. Undeveloped residential property within the City is required to be mowed and maintained a minimum of at least one time per month during the months of May, June, July, August, September, and October.

Ordinance No. 254 Amending City Code of Ely, Iowa Chapter 3-1-6 Fireworks

No person shall discharge a consumer fireworks device outside the following dates and hours:

- 1. June 29 through July 4 from the hours of 12 noon until 10pm. Exception: discharge hours are extended to 11pm on July 4th only.

Sausage Soufflé

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 can Cream of Mushroom Soup
- 2 1/2 C. Stuffing Croutons (seasoned)
- 2 C. Milk
- 2 C. Shredded Cheddar Cheese
- 1/4 C. Milk
- 4 Eggs (beaten)
- 34 Dry Mustard

Add a small amount of 2 C. milk to mustard and mix until smooth.

Combine with the rest of milk. Add meat, cheese and croutons to egg mixture and mix well. Spray 9" x 13" pan with spray oil. Refrigerate overnight or at least 6 hours. When ready to bake combine soup and 1/4 C. milk. Pour over top and poke holes so soup runs through. Bake at 350 1 hour until set. Allow to set 10 minutes before serving.
