A discussion was held on street projects for the 2020 Summer season. Options were presented for Knoll Court and North Drive North of Dows Street as well as Vista Road, Traer, Fuhrmeister, and Main Streets. Council gave direction to the city administrator to organize a small bond with Speer Financial and proceed with getting work lined up and to return with more information at the June meeting.

Council member Symonds moved to approve a small business water bill forgiveness program for businesses closed for the COVID-19 health emergency. Second by Whitaker. All ayes on a roll call vote.

Council member Hale moved to approve Pay Application #5 from Rathje for the North Water Main project in the amount of \$37,283.93. Second by Whitaker. All ayes on a roll call vote.
