Final Reading of an Ordinance Amending Zoning Code. Presented to council for consideration the final reading of an ordinance amending the zoning code for the City of Ely. A request has been received to amend zoning on 55.54 acres of property within the City of Ely from R1/R2 to only R2. This subdivision is now known as Founders Grove. This was reviewed and approved by the planning and zoning commission. Approximately 64% of the lots will be single family and 36% of the lots will be two-family owner occupied residential. Motion by Hale to close updated Zoning ordinance final reading as written, 2nd by Symonds. All Ayes-5 motion carried.

Final Reading of an Updated Noise Ordinance. Presented to council for consideration the final reading of an ordinance updating noise ordinance. Staff has prepared the code based on comment received from council and public. This update improves the code detail and allows for the noise infractions to be handled as a nuisance rather than only a criminal situation. The code had been updated after the first reading to including animal noise limits and more broad language regarding noise from mobile food units.
