Residents with a few items can drop them off at Ely's Waste Water Treatment Plant located at 1124 Vista Road. Residents with more than a few items may be asked to divert the materials directly to the Linn County Landfill located at 1954 County Home Road, Marion, Iowa.

There are 3 services available this year. **NO TIRES**

- Safe Disposal of Electronic Items – aka “E”Waste
- Safe Disposal of Bulky Household Items and Large Appliances
- Safe and Confidential Document Destruction.

Each of the above services will be on premise for you to take advantage of. There will be designated areas for each service. Please be sure to have your items grouped and ready for disposal.

DOCUMENT SHREDDING

Ely residents can bring a **maximum** of 6 boxes (no larger than banker's or paper box) of documents to be shred. Document Destruction & Recycling Service will be on site to collect your boxes, transport them to their facility and will provide professional, confidential destruction all documents in a secure & environmentally responsible manner.

ALL ITEMS WILL BE UNDER LOCK AND KEY AND PROTECTED FROM EXPOSURE.

Acceptable Bulky Household Items and Large Appliances:

There will be dumpsters for the following items:

- Furnaces/Air conditioners
- Humidifiers/Dehumidifiers
- Dishwashers
- Microwaves
- Washers/Dryers
- Refrigerators/Freezers
- Stoves/Ovens
- Trash compactors
- Furnaces/Water heaters
- Box springs/Mattresses
- Furniture
- Carpet/Carpet padding
- Home construction/Remodeling debris
- Old bicycles (*tires must be removed*)

Cardboard:

Must be kept separate, torn down and flat to place in a dumpster. There will be a dumpster for cardboard only and all cardboard will be taken to City Carton and properly disposed of.

Scrap Metal:

Aluminum, cast iron, exercise equipment, file cabinets, firepit rings, grills, lawn mowers, metal shelving, snow blowers, swing sets, wrought iron (Please note: “clean” metal only, free of plastic, glass, oil or gas.)

(Please note: regular household trash not accepted during citywide clean-up day.)

The Following Items Are Accepted Anytime at City Hall

Monday – Friday 8:00 am – 5:00 pm

Batteries that are no longer good-“A” through 9 Volt can be taken to Ely City Hall anytime during the year to be recycled.

NO Household Hazardous Materials

The Cedar Rapids/Linn County Solid Waste Agency will not be present for the Ely Clean Up Day. **RESIDENTIAL** household hazardous materials may be taken to the Cedar Rapids/Linn County Solid Waste Agency at **NO CHARGE** 7:00am-4:30pm Monday-Saturday. **NO APPOINTMENT NEEDED!** They are located at 1954 County Home Rd. Marion, IA 52302. Hazardous materials generated from a business are State & Federally regulated. All businesses, former businesses, or farms need to call the Cedar Rapids/Linn County Solid Waste Agency for more information and to set up an appointment time.
